- Executive Summary/Abstract
 - o One paragraph summary of your proposed collaborative research project
- Needs Assessment
 - o What social problem are you addressing?
- Program Goals and Objectives
 - O How does the project promote feminist social justice goals?
 - What will you accomplish with this collaborative research project?
 - What question(s) will you answer and why are they important?
- Methodology
 - What methods you will use for your activist research?
 - Timeline and expected outcomes from the project
- Qualifications
 - Courses, skills, or work and/or volunteer experiences that make you a good fit for this project
- o Any other relevant information that can help us with our decision
- 1. **Resume or CV** (no more than 2 pages long).
- 2. Letter from the organization confirming that you will be collaborating with them.
